

Report 2011-2012

We have had a very successful season with each age group achieving success, and all members have improved on their skill levels and enjoyed a very busy year.

The leisure centre gave us an extra this season and Pam Rainsley agreed to coach the U16 section, giving them another two years experience before moving them up to the U18/Ladies section. We still moved the more able players from the U14 to the U16 and U16 to U18.

Our Annual Tournament was a great success this year with 38 teams attending; we raised much-needed funds for the club. It was a beautiful sunny day but unfortunately we didn't get any winners but gained lots of experience. I was disappointed that we struggled to get helpers within the club, this is the only fund raising event we do and it is only once a year. All members of the club get the benefit from these funds as we subsidized all area's, from kit to match fees and affiliation to England Netball.

U12

We have had between 18 and 24 girls attend club on a regular basis with year groups from 5 to 7.

We entered a team in the Poole league this year; unfortunately we didn't get any medals but the girls gained valuable experience playing against stronger clubs in the Poole area.

We achieved level one, two and three skill awards for most of the girls.

We entered a U11 and U12 team in our annual tournament in March, U11 finished 5th in their group and the U12 4th in their group.

U13

We have had between 14 and 18 girls attend regularly, we entered a team in the Poole League this season which consists of year 8's, they had a mixed season never seeming to have a consistent seven, they finish the season in 5th place.

10 girls achieved their level four-skill award.

U14/U16

This being a new group this season, we have had attendance levels between 12 – 18, but once we have this age established there would be a natural progression into this group. Unfortunately this group did not get any match play as there was not enough interest to enter a team in the local league, hopefully we can improve on this next season. Pam was very pleased with their progress and the commitment level of the majority of players.

We entered a U14's team into our tournament in March, they started well but tired by the end of the day, finished in 8th place (in a group of 11), it was good for them to see the standard they need to reach against clubs outside Salisbury.

Emma Vaughan attended the Salisbury U14 netball development group and we had two girls join from that group towards the end of the season.

Ellie Rackham, Becca Healey, Emma Vaughan and Sophie Waddington have joined the U18 for Salisbury Summer League.

U18/Ladies

In this section we had between 16 and 22 attending club each week, the ladies team has been going for three seasons now and is well established. The U18 have a strong team with players who have been with the club since they were 9 years old. Both teams entered into the Salisbury League this year, this was divided into three parts, Winter/Spring and summer. The winter league was one division of 11 teams and played a round robin, the U18 finished 6th and the Ladies 5th. For the spring league this division was then split into two divisions, both teams playing in the 1st division. The U18 finished 3rd and the Ladies 2nd. The summer league is still in progress.

For the first time we have entered a team in the New Forest League in Division 2, this is a mixture of U18 and Ladies, so far they have only lost one match and this was to a team that was demoted from the 1st div last year.

There has been much improvement throughout the season and we hope this will continue.
